## Investment objective

Causeway Concentrated Equity Fund seeks long-term growth of capital.

The Fund invests at least 80% of its total assets in equity securities of companies in the U.S and in developed and emerging countries outside the U.S. The Fund will typically hold between 25 and 35 investments. Equity securities include common stock, preferred and preference stock, and depositary receipts.

**Market commentary**

Equity prices continued to decline in the second quarter as accelerated central bank tightening and recession fears weighed on the outlook for economic growth. The top performing markets in our investable universe were China, Hong Kong, the Czech Republic, Portugal, and Kuwait. The worst performing markets were Peru, Colombia, Poland, Hungary, and Brazil. The best performing sectors in the MSCI ACWI Index ("Index") were energy, consumer staples, and utilities. The worst performing sectors were information technology, consumer discretionary, and materials. Currency proved a headwind as major currencies declined against the US dollar.

The Causeway Concentrated Equity Fund ("Fund") outperformed the Index during the quarter, due primarily to stock selection. Fund holdings in the materials, insurance, and banks industry groups, as well as an underweight position in the semiconductors & semi equipment and automobiles & components industry groups, contributed to relative performance. Holdings in the utilities industry group, along with an overweight position in the software & services industry group and an underweight position in the food beverage & tobacco, energy, and telecommunication services industry groups, offset some of the outperformance compared to the Index. The top contributor to return was pharmaceutical giant, Sanofi (France). Other notable contributors included specialty chemicals manufacturer, Ashland Global Holdings, Inc. (United States), life insurer, Prudential Plc (United Kingdom), electric utility provider, RWE AG (Germany), and clinical laboratory, Quest Diagnostics, Inc. (United States). The largest detractor was travel & tourism technology company, Sabre Corp. (United States). Additional notable detractors included electronic equipment manufacturer, Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd. (South Korea), technology conglomerate, Alphabet, Inc. (United States), jet engine manufacturer, Rolls-Royce Holdings Plc (United Kingdom), and electric, gas & renewables power generation & distribution company, Enel SpA (Italy).
