The Fund's investment objective is to seek long-term growth of capital.

The Fund normally invests at least 80% of its total assets in equity securities of companies in emerging (less developed) markets and other investments that are tied economically to emerging markets.

Market commentary

Buoyed by positive COVID-19 vaccine developments, emerging markets ("EM") were top performers within the global equity universe during the fourth quarter. The MSCI Emerging Markets Index ("Index") returned 16.09% in local currency terms during the period. Emerging Latin America was the top performing region group during the quarter. The emerging Asia and emerging Europe, Middle East, and Africa ("EMEA") region groups also posted strong absolute returns. Information technology, materials, and financials were the top performing sectors in the Index. Real estate, consumer discretionary, and communication services were the weakest sectors during the period.

Causeway Emerging Markets Fund ("Fund") performed in-line with the Index in the fourth quarter. We use both bottom-up "stock-specific" and top-down factor categories to seek to forecast alpha for the stocks in the Fund's investable universe. Our bottom-up growth factor was a positive indicator during the quarter. Our bottom-up valuation and price momentum factors were negative indicators. In December, we added a new competitive strength bottom-up factor category to our alpha model. After extensive research, we found that an industry's competitive landscape and a company's position within it have been closely linked to changes in profitability and, ultimately, a stock's return potential. These new alpha factors examine current levels and longer-term trends in a broad range of metrics relevant to competitive strength: margins, returns, competition, industry structure, market share, and balance sheet strength. Of our top-down factors, country was a positive indicator while sector, macroeconomic, and currency were negative.

Over the quarter, Fund holdings in the EMEA region group contributed to relative performance, attributable in part to positive stock selection in South Africa. Positioning in Brazil and Mexico contributed to relative performance in the emerging Latin America region group. In the emerging Asia region group, negative stock selection in China more than offset positive stock selection in Taiwan. From a sector perspective, the greatest contributors to relative performance were information technology, financials, and materials. The largest detractors from relative performance were consumer discretionary, health care, and energy. The greatest stock-level contributors to relative performance included overweight positions in Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co., Ltd., internet services provider, Baidu (China), and diversified metals & mining operator, Vale SA (Brazil). The largest stock-level detractors from relative performance included underweight positions in e-commerce platform, Pinduoduo (China), and electric vehicle maker, NIO (China), as well as an overweight position in internet commerce company, Alibaba Group Holding (China).
